
Trip Details – Laos/Thailand

- Cost: \$4985









Trip Details - Morocco

## The Application Process

- Student applications are due by Tuesday, May 21st at noon
- Only complete applications will be accepted for consideration
- A complete application includes:
  - Copy of passport (valid until October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020)\*
  - Copy of birth certificate
  - Completed paperwork
  - Student Statement of Interest (TYPED and SIGNED)
  - TWO reference surveys
  - THREE post-dated cheques
- Once completed applications have been submitted, students will complete an application interview with Mr. Chu
- Or documentation indicating passport has been submitted for renewal
